
SURVEY RESULTS

Have you attended an event at the City Auditorium in the past year?






BUILDING USE

What are the 3 most successful events held at the City Auditorium that you would like to see hosted there in the future?






BUILDING USE

With staffing in mind, when should the City Auditorium be available to the Public?



Would you support a minor tax increase to fund on-going facility costs?
















PROPOSED IMPROVEMENTS









PROPOSED MAIN LEVEL




















OPINION OF PROBABLE COST

GRANT FUNDING – Civic and Community Center Financing Fund (CCCFF)

PHASE 1 - PLANNING

 Establishes short & long term goals for the future development of a Community Center.

PHASE 2 - CAPITAL CONSTRUCTION

- Provides an opportunity for the City to apply for funding (\$562,000) to implement many of the goals outlined within the final Feasibility Study.
- NDED will not be awarding Phase 2 in 2021 – Alma CCCFF Application due in early 2022
