Motion by Davis, second by Moulton to accept special designated liquor license for The Station/Kent Shaffer for a reception at the Alma City Auditorium on 2-22-2020. Mayor opened the floor to Administrator Wilson to discuss the information he received from Olsson's on the storage unit utilities at the Western Sky Subdivision. It would cost the city \$60,000 to provide the utilities to the 6 lots that are zoned Commercial. The city will not be doing it at this time.
