Hoesch Memorial Library Board of Trustees met on Monday May 1, 2023 at 4:00 p.m. Present were Don Jardon, Mary Jo Radil, Cathy House, Pam Miller and Keri Anderson, Library Director. Bryan Lubeck was absent.

Don Jardon called the meeting to order with attention given to the Open Meeting Act posted on the conference Room Wall.

Keri will be on vacation from May 4 to May 12. We will continue the policy review at a future meeting. We were reminded that because of the BRAN Bike Ride on June 5, the library will be open to the riders from 1:00 to 8:00 on that day so they can have access to the internet, air conditioning, and rest rooms.
